Targeting deserving NHS graduates, \$274,000 has been awarded from 2003 to 2019, to 65 students. In 2003, five students received the first year awards – see photo above. A unique feature of this fund is the multi-year award which students may apply for if they meet the renewal requirements, for a total of four years of scholarship.
